

# OPEN SPACES 2018 – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**NOW NO ONE WANTS TO WAVE A FAT RULEBOOK, BUT WE HAVE TO KEEP THE CONVENT SAFE AND CLEAN FOR EVERYONE, SO WE HAVE A FEW NON-NEGOTIABLE CONDITIONS:**

1. Tickets are sold subject to the Festival conditions of sale and to the terms and conditions of entry to the Festival venue. All sales are final. This is an all-weather Festival.
2. We reserve the right to add, withdraw or substitute artists, vary any advertised program, change venue and vary audience capacity. No claim for compensation shall be made in the event that the program is varied due to the non-appearance of an advertised artist.
3. We may refuse admission to any ticket holder for any reasonable cause and may request any ticket holder to leave the venue for any reasonable cause.
4. In the case of an emergency evacuation or situation, you must follow all Festival and other official directives.

5. **PROHIBITED ITEMS**

**All bags/containers may be subject to a full search.**

The following items are prohibited from being brought into the Event:

- a. **NO ALCOHOL**  
There are licensed areas within the Festival event area. Any found or discovered alcohol which was brought into the Festival will be confiscated.
  - b. **NO OPEN DRINK CONTAINERS**  
The contents of any open container will not be permitted into the Festival.  
Sealed drink containers will be permitted.
  - c. **NO SHARPS**  
This includes sharp cutlery such as forks and knives.  
Syringes/needles required for medical reasons will be permitted and should be disposed of after use in the sharps bins provided in restrooms.
  - d. **NO GLASS**  
No glass must be brought into any part of the Festival.
  - e. **NO ILLEGAL DRUGS, WEAPONS, or DANGEROUS ITEMS**  
Persons found in possession of these items will be removed from the venue, and may face criminal charges. The use of candles, incense, fire or fireworks of any kind is strictly prohibited throughout the site.
6. No claim may be made against the Festival or the venue provider for prohibited items which are confiscated.

7. Ticket holders agree to comply with all Festival security arrangements, as well as those of the venue provider, including bag searches (if deemed necessary by the Festival).
8. Alcohol purchased from licensed premises at the Convent must not be consumed beyond the bounds of those premises. Anyone found supplying or buying alcohol for a minor will be evicted from the event.
9. **ENTRY IS AT YOUR OWN RISK**
  - a. You will be liable for any loss or damage caused at the event by you or your invitees.
  - b. We disclaim any and all liability for the acts, omissions and conduct of any third party including the products, services, actions or failure to act of the Festival venue or other person in connection with the Festival or otherwise referred to on this website.
  - c. We take no responsibility for any hearing damage or loss, please use ear plugs if necessary.
  - d. Activities such as moshing, crowd surfing and stage-diving are not permitted. Patrons engaging in these or other dangerous activities will be evicted from the Festival.
  - e. Appropriate footwear and clothing must be worn at all times while attending the Festival.
  - f. The Convent site is a pedestrian zone and children must be supervised at all times.
10. **RESPECT OUR ENVIRONMENT AND COMMUNITY**
  - a. Please place any litter in the recycle or other bins provided around the Festival. Place all cigarette butts in the bins provided or take them home with you.
  - b. Only domestic animals will be admitted to the Festival. Dogs must remain on a leash at all times and owners must bring their own dog poo bags.
  - c. Please respect the Abbotsford Convent space and surrounds, and do not create excessive noise or litter while traveling to and from the Festival.
  - d. Picking of foliage and playing in the garden beds is prohibited.
11. All ticket holders consent to any official filming and sound recording as members of the audience.
12. Trading signs or other signs are not permitted without our prior written consent. No ticket holder shall be entitled to do any trading without the written consent of the Festival organisers.
13. Any breach of any terms and conditions will entitle the Festival organisers to evict the patron from the venue without refund.
